Museums and Exhibitions Division is an organization under the Department of Archives and Museums, Mahidol University Library and Knowledge Center.

Our division was established in November 2010 with a significant role to collect and convey the information about the university's history, culture, and achievement to students, staff, and visitors.

We provide service for welcoming the visitors to the exhibition hall of "Mahidol University Archives and Museums", on the 2nd and 3rd floor of the Mahidol Learning Center Building, at Mahidol University Salaya. This hall serves as the main place for everyone to learn and know more about the university from past to the present, with two main exhibitions "H.R.H The Prince Father's Biography Gallery" and "Mahidol University Hall of Fame".

We also provide the training courses to build the team of volunteer students called "MU Guide", working as a host in each visiting program.

Moreover, on the important days of Mahidol University, we hold the exhibitions about the university and its related stories, in order to inspire people and make them proud of being a part of Mahidol University's journey, as known as the institution for all mankind or "Wisdom of the Land".



H.R.H. The Prince Father's Biography Gallery



H.R.H. The Prince Father's Biography Gallery features the Prince Father's biography and important objects relating to the Prince Father who is regarded as role model and soul of Mahidol Community. The gallery is divided into 7 Zones:

- Wisdom of the Land
- 'Chao Fa' of the Land
- The Traveler Prince
- The Light of Wisdom
- Medical Treatment Rendered with Affection
- Kanphai Mahidol
- Taking Roots in the Land

Mahidol University Hall of Fame



Mahidol University Hall of Fame focuses on the history and development of Mahidol University from past to present including achievements by members of Mahidol Community for the benefits of the society.

On the 2nd floor, the exhibition presents about Mahidol's achievements and Core Values. On the 3rd floor, is about the history and revolution of the university through different periods of time, the exhibition is divided by content into 3 zones:

- "Mahidol Today"
- Originally Established as "University of Medical Sciences"
- "Mahidol" – On the Path to Excellence

Annual Exhibitions

In each year, Museums and Exhibitions Division will organize exhibitions to commemorate the important days of Mahidol University.

The first event is on the occasion of "The Royal Bestowal of Mahidol University's Name" on 2 March, and the second is "The Mahidol Day" on 24 September. Further exhibitions will be held if there are other special occasions during that year.
